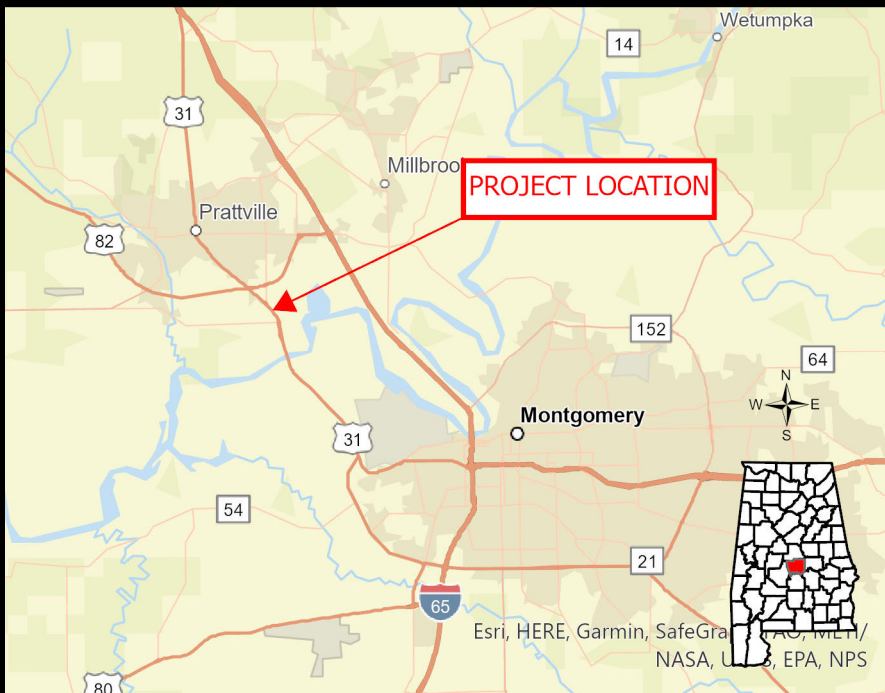

The Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT) is proposing to implement access modifications along AL-3 (US-31) and the installation of a green-t signal at the intersection of AL-3 (US-31) and McQueen Smith Road in Prattville, Alabama. Comments for the proposed project must be submitted by **March 8, 2024**.



Project Description

ALDOT is proposing access modifications along AL-3 (US-31) and the installation of a Green-T Signal in Elmore County, near Prattville. Improvements at this intersection will provide a smoother travel experience and will benefit the traveling public by providing a safer intersection for those using US-31 and McQueen Smith Road.
