RE: FY 2024 Transportation Alternatives Set-Aside Program Call for Applications

The Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT) is soliciting applications for the Transportation Alternatives Set-Aside Program (TAP) for FY 2024.

All applications **must be submitted electronically** no later than 5:00 pm on <u>May 31, 2023</u>. Applications should be sent to <u>tapapp@dot.state.al.us</u> as a .pdf file (25 mb max) with "FY 2024 TAP Application – *Sponsor Name*" in the subject line.

Please refer to the FY 2024 Transportation Alternative Set-Aside Guidelines and the FY 2024 Transportation Alternative Set-Aside Application for details about the program and the application submittal process. The current deadline for application submittals and the subsequent announcement of project selections will allow sponsors to receive a notice of award before the start of the upcoming fiscal year. This will allow sponsors an opportunity to program the required matching funds into their upcoming fiscal year's operating budgets.
