LIST V-1

REFLECTIVE SHEETING FOR TRAFFIC CONTROL

1. **Material:** Reflective sheeting for sign faces and barricades placed on the approved list.
2. **Specification:** Article 880.02
3. **Jurisdiction:** Product Evaluation Board, Paint Laboratory
4. **Job Acceptance Requirements:** No Job Control samples required if material works satisfactorily. Finished signs should be sampled and tested according to the schedule found in the Department's "Testing Manual" and Department procedure ALDOT-245.
5. **Project Engineer's Responsibility:** The project engineer will be responsible for sampling and inspection as outlined in the Department's "Testing Manual"
 - 6.2 For digitally printed reflective sheeting, only sheeting printed by approved digital printer systems (systems will be defined as sheeting type and color, printer, ink, and clear overlay film) will be evaluated for approval and inclusion on the approved list. Approved digital printer systems are listed on List V-1.
6. **Producer's Initial Requirements:** Companies wishing to have products evaluated for placement on this list must contact the American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials (AASHTO) Product Evaluation & Audit Solutions (formerly National Transportation Product Evaluation Program (NTPEP)):

7. **Producer's Maintenance Requirements:**
 - 7.1 Produce the same quality of material as the material supplied for the original evaluation.
 - 7.2 Provide only approved products to Department projects.
 - 7.3 Promptly report to the Department any changes in company name, product name, company address or company ownership.
 - 7.4 Notify the Department of any changes in production of the product. Any alteration that will change the product physically will require a reevaluation of the product.
 - 7.5 Furnish certified test reports covering all parameters found in the department specifications, with each shipment.
8. **Laboratory Testing:** The Department will check all data submitted for the product to insure compliance with the Department's Specifications.
9. **Contractors' Requirements:** The prime contractor will be responsible for purchasing and using only approved products.
10. **Removal of Products:** Products may be removed from this list for any of the following:
 - 10.1 Mislabeling products or substitution of products other than those originally submitted.
 - 10.2 Failure to meet any of the Department's requirements for this type of material.
 - 10.3 Failure to work satisfactorily on the job.
