**PORTLAND AND BLENDED CEMENTS**

1. **Material:** Portland and blended cements
2. **Specification:** Section 815
3. **Jurisdiction:** Product Evaluation Board,  
(Concrete Engineer)
4. **Job Acceptance Requirements:** No job control testing required if material comes from a listed source and performs satisfactorily.
5. **Project Engineer's Responsibility:** The Project Engineer must verify that the provisions required in Department Procedure ALDOT-227 are executed and that all cement comes from approved sources.
6. **Producer's Initial Requirements:**

7. **Producer's Maintenance Requirements:**  
Companies with manufacturing facilities on this list will be expected to comply with the following to remain on the list:  
7.1 Companies with products on this list will be expected to comply with all aspects of Department Procedure ALDOT-227.  
7.2 Produce the same quality of material as the material supplied for the original evaluation.
- 7.3 Provide only approved products to Department projects.
- 7.4 Promptly report to the Department any changes in company name, product name, company address or company ownership.
- 7.5 Participate and successfully complete an annual NTPEP audit and furnish the Department with a copy of the final report.
8. **Laboratory Testing:** The Department will make selected verification tests of the product to assure that it meets current specifications.
9. **Contractor's Requirements:** The prime contractor will be responsible for ensuring compliance with Department Procedure ALDOT-227 and for purchasing and using only approved cements.
10. **Removal of Sources:** Sources will be removed from this list for failure to comply with Department Procedure ALDOT-227 or the Department Specifications.
