TACKIFIERS, MULCH CONTROL NETTING and HYDRAULIC MULCH PRODUCTS

- 1. <u>Material:</u> Tackifier Adhesives, Mulch Control Netting and Hydraulic Mulch Products intended to protect slopes against the hydraulic erosive forces of precipitation and sheet flow and enhance the establishment of vegetation.
- 2. **Specification:** Section 656 and Article 860.03
- 3. <u>Jurisdiction:</u> Product Evaluation Board, Construction Bureau
- 4. <u>Job Acceptance Requirements:</u> No job control samples necessary if the product performs satisfactorily.
- 5. <u>Project Manager's Responsibility:</u> Check and assure that the materials are on the approved list.
- Producer's Initial Requirements: The producer shall submit an ALDOT New Product Evaluation Request Form and fees according to ALDOT procedure BMTP-355 to the ALDOT Product Evaluation Board to be considered for placement on the list.
- 6.1 Submit manufacturer's literature including brochures, specification, manufacturer's installation or application requirements.
- 6.2 Tackifiers Submit a standard Material Safety Data Sheet and acute and chronic toxicity test reports.
- 6.3 Mulch Control Netting Submit documentation of biodegradation, mass per unit area, tensile strength, and percent open area.
- 6.4 Hydraulic Mulch Products Submit a standard Material Safety Data Sheet and a full report from an independent lab of ASTM D 6459-07 and ASTM D 7322.

- Producer's Maintenance Requirements: Companies with products on this list will be expected to comply with the following to remain on the list:
- 7.1 Produce the same quality and composition of material as the material supplied for the original evaluation.
- 7.2 Provide only approved products to Department projects.
- 7.3 Provide manufacturer's installation instructions and labels clearly identifying each package of product including the production date and lot number.
- 7.4 Promptly report to the Department any changes in company name, product name, company address, or company ownership.
- 7.5 Notify the Department of any changes in production of the product. Any alteration that could change the product physically or chemically will require a reevaluation of the product.
- 8. <u>Laboratory Testing:</u> The Department may make selected verification tests of the product to assure compliance with the Department's specifications.
- Contractor's Requirements: All contractors will be responsible for purchasing and using only approved products.
- 10. <u>Removal of Products:</u> Products may be removed from this list for any of the following:
- 10.1 Mislabeling products or substitution of products other than those originally submitted and approved.
- 10.2 Failure to comply with any of the Department's requirements for this type of material.
- 10.3 Failure to perform satisfactorily on the job.
