- Material: Portable Barriers, Impact Attenuators, End Anchors, Guiderails, and Miscellaneous Items
- Specification: Applicable Section(s) 864, 720, 726, and/ or 740 of the Department's Specifications.
- Jurisdiction: Product Evaluation Board, Design Bureau
- Job Acceptance Requirements: No job control samples necessary if the product performs satisfactory.
- Project Engineer's Responsibly: Check and assure that the materials are on the approved list.
- 6. Producer's Initial Requirements: Companies wishing to have a product evaluated for the placement on this list must furnish the Department's Product Evaluation Engineer with the following:
- 6.1 Name and address of the company producing the product.
- 6.2 For Portable Barriers, Impact Attenuators, End Anchors, and Guiderails the Crash Testing results for NCHRP-350 Test Level (TL-2), (TL-3), and/or (TL-4), now known as MASH-08 shall be submitted, FHWA's approval letter for the product's use on National Highways, and access to drawings for construction use such as a website address.
- 6.3 Submittal fees according to the Department's procedure BMTP-355.
- Producer's Maintenance Requirements: Companies with products on this list will be expected to comply with the following to remain on the list:
- 7.1 Produce the same quality of material as the material supplied for the original evaluation.
- 7.2 Provide only approved products to Department projects.
- 7.3 Promptly report any changes in company name, product name, company address or company ownership to the Department's Product Evaluation Engineer.
- 7.4 Notify the Department of any changes in production of the product. Any alteration that will change the product physically will require a reevaluation of the product.
- Laboratory Testing: The Department will check all data submitted for the product to assure compliance with the Department's Specifications.

- Contractor's Requirements: The prime contractor will be responsible for purchasing and using only approved products.
- Removal of Products: Products may be removed from this list for any of the following:
- 10.1 Mislabeling products or substitution of products other than those originally submitted.
- 10.2 Failure to comply with any of the Department's requirements for this type of material.
- 10.3 Failure to work satisfactorily on the job.
