Planned Lane Closure on I-59 NB, in St. Clair County

From just South of the Ashville Exit (MP 166) to the Etowah County Line (MP 175)

St. Clair County - Beginning at 7 a.m., Monday, December 4, the Alabama Department of Transportation will close the right lane of I-59 Northbound for Paving Operations from just south of the Ashville Exit (Milepost 156) to Etowah County Line (Milepost 175).

All travel lanes are expected to re-open at approximately 4 p.m. on Monday, December 4.

This same lane closure will be in place from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Tuesday.

Motorists are requested to consider using alternate routes, adjust arrival/departure times, observe work zone speed limits and other work zone signs, and use extreme caution in this area. ALDOT thanks motorists for their patience during this construction operation to improve Alabama's roadways.

Planned Lane Closures Extended, in Talladega County

TALLADEGA - Weather permitting, the Alabama Department of Transportation's project to resurface the I-20 Eastbound (center and inside) lanes from approximately Milepost 179 to Milepost 182, in Talladega County has been extended to Sunday, December 3rd.

This work will require the I-20 Eastbound (center and inside) lanes to be closed from approximately 8 a.m. - 8 p.m.

Travel delays should be expected during resurfacing activities, in this area.

From the Steele exit (MP 174) to the Ashville exit (MP 166)

This lane will be closed for the removal of trees and debris.

Planned Lane Closures on I-65 NB, in Blount County

From just north of the Hayden Exit (MP 284.9) to the Blount Springs Exit (MP 287)

Blount County - Beginning at approximately 9 a.m., Monday, December 4, the Alabama Department of Transportation will close the left lane of I-65 northbound for Inlet Cleaning Operations from just north of the Hayden Exit (Milepost 284.9) to the Blount Springs Exit (Milepost 287).

Planned Lane Closure for Bridge Inspection on I-65 at MP 232.19, in Calera

CALERA – Weather permitting, on Thursday December 7 at 9 a.m., the Alabama Department of Transportation will perform a bridge inspection on the County Road 22 bridge over I-65 at Milepost 232.19, as follows:

- The inspection will require the outside (right) lane and shoulder of I-65 southbound to be closed in the area of the work. Following completion of work in the outside lane, work will continue in the southbound inside (left) lane in a similar manner.
- Once work is completed in the southbound direction, work will continue in the northbound direction. In the northbound direction, the inspection will require the outside (right) lane and shoulder of I-65 NB to be closed in the area of work.
- All travel lanes will be reopened to traffic no later than 3 p.m.
