### **Planned Lane Closures on Ross Bridge Parkway, in Birmingham**

**BIRMINGHAM** – Weather permitting, Wednesday, July 5 at 8 a.m. thru Wednesday, July 8 at 4:30 p.m., the Alabama Department of Transportation plans to have lane closures in place on Ross Bridge Parkway at the intersection of John Hawkins Parkway (SR-150).

The purpose of these lane closures will be to install new storm sewer pipe below Ross Bridge Parkway. This work is being done as part of the bridge replacement and relocation project on SR-150 at Shades Creek and SR-150.

Motorists are requested to consider using alternate routes, adjust arrival/departure times, observe work zone speed limits and other work zone signs, and use extreme caution in this area. ALDOT thanks motorists for their patience during this Construction Operation to improve Alabama's roadways.

### **Planned Lane Closures on Ross Bridge Parkway, in Birmingham**

**BIRMINGHAM** – Weather permitting, the Alabama Department of Transportation plans to have lane closures in place on Ross Bridge Parkway at the Intersection of John Hawkins Parkway (SR-150) as follows:

- Friday, July 7th at 8.30 a.m. until 4:30 p.m. there will be one lane closed in each direction on Ross Bridge Parkway.
- Saturday, July 8th at 5:30 a.m. until 7 p.m. Sunday, July 9th there will one lane closed in each on Ross Ridge Parkway.

The purpose of these lane closures will be to install a drainage pipe below Ross Bridge Parkway. This work is being done as part of the bridge replacement and relocation project on SR-150 at Shades Creek and SR-150.

Motorists are requested to consider using alternate routes, adjust arrival/departure times, observe work zone speed limits and other work zone signs, and use extreme caution in this area. ALDOT thanks motorists for their patience during this Construction Operation to improve Alabama's roadways.

#### **Planned Guardrail Repairs on Outside Shoulders and in the Median of I-65, I-59, US 280, US 78 and I-22, in Birmingham**

**BIRMINGHAM** – On Tuesday, July 11, weather permitting, beginning at 8 p.m., the Alabama Department of Transportation will begin repairs to the guardrail located in the following locations:

- **I-65** – on the outside shoulders and median in the southbound and northbound directions from the Blount County Line (MP 283.9) in Warrior to the Shelby County Line (MP 248.9) in Hoover. This work may require closure of the outside (right) and the inside (left) lanes at various times and locations in the area where guardrail repairs are being made.
- **I-59** – on the outside shoulders and median in the northbound and southbound directions from the Tuscaloosa County Line (MP 100.9) in Bessemer to the St. Clair County Line (MP 147.9) in Argo. This work may require closure of the outside (right) and the inside (left) lanes at various times and locations in the area where guardrail repairs are being made.
- **US 280** – on the outside shoulders and median in the eastbound and westbound directions from the US 31 Interchange (MP 0.0) in Homewood to the Shelby County Line (MP 5.9) in Birmingham. This work may require closure of the outside (right) and the inside (left) lanes at various times and locations in the area where guardrail repairs are being made.
- **US 78** – on the outside shoulders and median in the westbound and eastbound directions from the Finley Blvd. Interchange (MP 135.3) in Birmingham to the Walker County Line (MP 154.7) in Sumiton. This work may require closure of the outside (right) and the inside (left) lanes at various times and locations in the area where guardrail repairs are being made.
- **I-22** – on the outside shoulders and median in the westbound and eastbound directions from the I-65 Interchange (MP 96.0) in Birmingham to the Walker County Line (MP 80.2) in Quinton. This work may require closure of the outside (right) and the inside (left) lanes at various times and locations in the area where guardrail repairs are being made.

Upon completion of all guardrail repairs on the outside (right) shoulders, the repairs will move to the inside (left) median shoulders in both the northbound/eastbound and southbound/westbound directions, which will require the inside (left) travel lane and shoulder to be closed in areas where the guardrail repairs are being made.

This work may require intermittent lane closures for up to eight weeks.

Motorists are requested to consider using alternate routes, adjust arrival/departure times, observe work zone speed limits and other work zone signs, and use extreme caution in this area. ALDOT thanks motorists for their patience during this maintenance operation to improve Alabama's roadways.

#### **Major Traffic Shift/New Alignment along US 78/SR 5, in Birmingham**

**BIRMINGHAM** – Weather permitting, Saturday, July 15 the Alabama Department of Transportation will be performing a permanent traffic shift/ new alignment along US 78/State Route 5 (Arkadelphia Rd.) from the I-59 Overpass to Finley Blvd. The project will proceed as follows:

- The contractor will be performing a permanent traffic shift/ new alignment along US 78/ SR 5 (Arkadelphia Rd.) from the I-59 Overpass to Finley Blvd on Saturday, July 15. The contractor will be shifting traffic from the existing roadway and bridge to the newly constructed roadway and bridge and will also be installing traffic control signage and devices, removing and installing stripping, and realigning existing traffic signals.
- The in-place detour of 12<sup>th</sup> Ave West will be removed and the intersection of 12<sup>th</sup> Ave West and US78/ SR 5 (Arkadelphia Rd.) will be reopened.
- This new traffic realignment is necessary to complete the widening of US 78 and the replacement of the railroad overpass bridge and is expected to be in place for approximately 12 months. The contractor will begin work at 6:30 am and will be completed by 5:30 pm of each day.

Expect major delays near the I-59 and US 78/ SR 5 (Arkadelphia Rd.) Intersection and the Finley Blvd and US 78/ SR 5 (Arkadelphia Rd.) Intersection due to periodic traffic stoppages to perform the work listed above.

US 78 traffic is encouraged to use an alternate route (ex. I-65 and Finley Blvd.).

There will be multiple troopers on site assisting with this operation.

Motorists are requested to consider using alternate routes, adjust arrival/departure times, observe work zone speed limits and other work zone signs, and use extreme caution in this area. ALDOT thanks motorists for their patience during this Construction Operation to improve Alabama's roadways.

#### **11<sup>th</sup> Avenue North Exit Ramp Closure, in Birmingham**

*Central Business District Project – Phase III*

#### **Planned Emergency Paving Repairs on I-65 SB, in Warrior**

*From the south end of the bridge over AL 160 (MP 284.326) to the north end of the bridge over the Service Rd. at Exit 280 (MP 281.0)*

**BIRMINGHAM** – Weather permitting, Sunday, July 23, the Alabama Department of Transportation will begin patching the rough pavement on I-65 southbound from the south end of the bridge over AL 160 (MP 284.326) to the north end of the bridge over the Service Road at Exit 280 (MP 281.0), in Warrior.

This work will require the outside (right) and middle lanes to be closed in the area the repairs are being made. The paving will take place from 6 p.m. thru approximately 5 a.m. nightly, Sunday thru Thursday.

This pavement repair operation is expected to last for five (5) days only, at this time.

#### **Replacement of Impact Attenuators (Crash Cushions) on AL 3/US 31, in Vestavia and Inlet Cleaning on I-59, in Birmingham**

The scheduled times are as follows:

##### **Saturday, July 29**

###### **6:00 a.m. thru 12:00 p.m.:**

- Replacement of the Impact Attenuator in the northbound direction of AL 3/US 31 (Milepost 266.6). This work will require the outside (right) lane to be closed during this operation.

###### **12:00 p.m. thru 6:00 p.m.:**

- Replacement of the Impact Attenuator in the southbound direction of AL 3/US 31 (Milepost 266.6). This work will require the outside (right) lane to be closed during this operation.

##### **Sunday, July 30**

###### **6:00 a.m. thru 6:00 p.m.:**

- Inlets will be cleaned in the southbound direction of I-59 from the Carraway Blvd. Exit (Exit 126-A) to the south end of the CBD Bridge. This work will require the inside (left) lane to be closed at various times throughout the day.
