#### **Planned Lane Closure on I-59 NB in St. Clair County**

*From north of the St Clair Springs Exit (MP 156) to south of the Ashville Exit (MP 166)*

**St. Clair County** – Beginning at 7 a.m., Monday, January 8, *weather permitting*, the Alabama Department of Transportation will close the right lane of I-59 Northbound for *Paving Operations* from north of the St. Clair Springs Exit (MP 156) to south of the Ashville Exit (MP 166).

All travel lanes are expected to reopen at approximately 4 p.m. on Monday.

This same lane closure will be in place from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m., Tuesday, January 9, thru Saturday, January 13.

Motorists are requested to consider using alternate routes, adjust arrival/departure times, observe work zone speed limits and other work zone signs, and use extreme caution in this area. ALDOT thanks motorists for their patience during this construction operation to improve Alabama's roadways.
