Project to Add Lanes and Widen Bridges on I-65 Starts next Week, in Shelby County

SHELBY COUNTY – Weather permitting, January 15, the Alabama Department of Transportation will begin a project to add lanes and widen bridges on I-65 from the State Route 3 Interchange (US 31 – Exit 238) in Alabaster to the County Road 52 Interchange (Exit 242) in Pelham.

More information will follow as the project progresses.

The contract has been awarded to Dunn Construction and Wiregrass Construction as a Joint Venture for \$67.5 million

The estimated completion time for this project is Fall 2020.

Motorists are requested to consider using alternate routes, adjust arrival/departure times, observe work zone speed limits and other work zone signs, and use extreme caution in this area. ALDOT thanks motorists for their patience during this construction to improve Alabama's roadways.
