Resurfacing US-11 and Ramp Modifications on I-20 at Exits 130, 130A and 130B

The Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT) is proposing to resurface US-11 (1st Avenue North) and permanently close the ramp on I-20 at Exit 130B in Birmingham, Jefferson County, Alabama. Comments for the proposed project must be submitted by September 30, 2022.



Project Description Proposed

- Resurfacing and maintenance work will be performed on 1st Avenue North from 25th Street North to 83rd Street North
- ♦ Closure of the 130B ramp on I-20 to 1st Avenue North (US-11)
- **♦** Alternatives:

Alt A: Use existing routes

Alt B: Modify the 130A Exit Ramp to add a left turn lane onto 1st Avenue North

 Restripe I-20 Eastbound for two continues lanes at Exit 130 with traffic from I-59 South merging onto I-20
