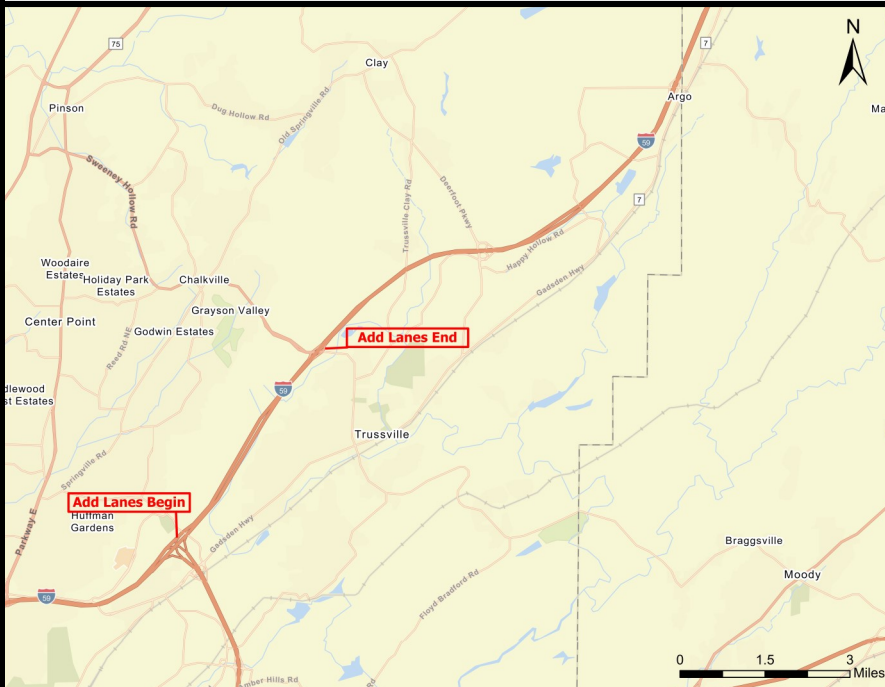


Online and In-Person Public Involvement

Reconstruction and Lane Addition on I-59 from I-459 to CR-10 (Chalkville Mountain Road)

The Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT) is proposing to reconstruct and add an additional lane in each direction on I-59 from the I-459 interchange to Chalkville Mountain Road in Trussville, Alabama. Information about the project is available to the public for review and comment. Your comments may be provided by mail, email, or voicemail described below. Comments for the proposed project must be submitted by April 8, 2022.



Project Description

- ◆ Full depth removal and replacement of the existing pavement—mainline and ramps
- ◆ Addition of a travel lane on I-59-NB and I-59-SB
- ◆ Bridge Deck replacement on I-59 over Edwards Lake Road
- ◆ No additional right-of-way required
- ◆ Intermittent lane closures and detours
