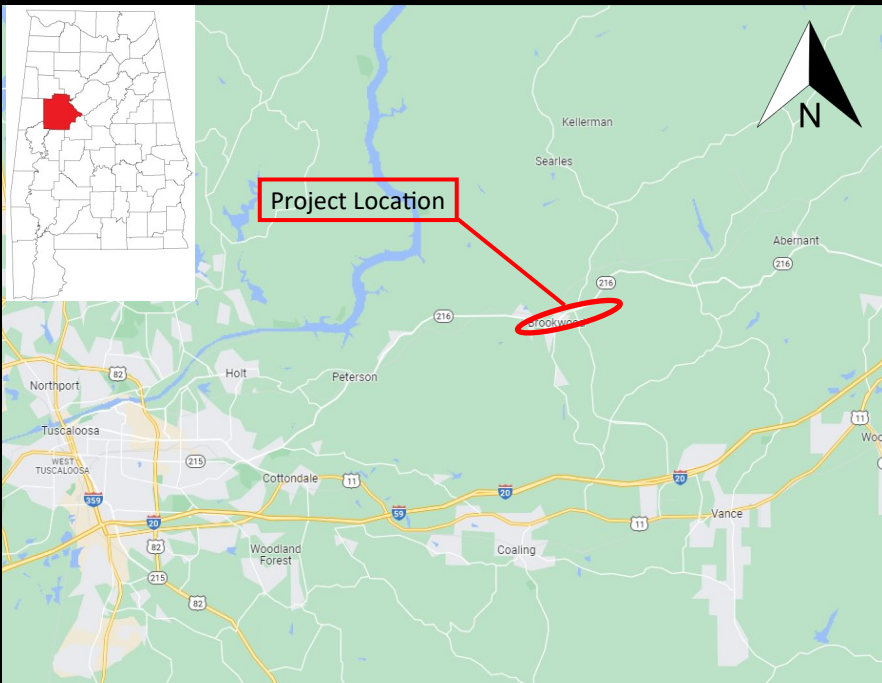

AL-216 Access Improvements

The Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT) is proposing access improvements on AL-216 from Covered Bridge Parkway to George Richmond Parkway in Tuscaloosa County, Alabama. Information about the project is available to the public for review and comment. Your comments may be provided by US mail, email, voicemail, or online as described below. Comments for the proposed project must be submitted by **October 28, 2023**.



Project Description

Project begins at approximately 350 ft west of Covered Bridge Parkway and extends to George Richmond Parkway.

The proposed project involves resurfacing, signal upgrades, modifications to existing driveways, landscaping, pedestrian sidewalks and lighting. These improvements aim to provide access improvements and pedestrian connectivity from Jack's Restaurant to Brookwood High School.
