

Additional Truck Climbing Lanes on AL -1(US-431)

The Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT) is proposing the addition of three truck climbing lanes on AL-1 (US-431) near the Towns of Roanoke and LaFayette, Chambers County, Alabama. Information about the project is available to the public for review and comment. Your comments may be provided by US mail, email, voicemail, or online as described below. Comments for the proposed project must be submitted by **June 3, 2024**.



Project Description

The proposed project is being implemented to improve traffic operations and motorists safety along US-431.

The project proposes to add 3 truck passing lanes on US-431 to assist drivers to safely maneuver around other vehicles at dedicated locations.

The first truck passing lane is located north of LaFayette between CR-167 and CR-226 in the north-bound direction.

The remaining truck passing lanes will be constructed south of Roanoke on US-431 in each direction between CR-246/CR-278 and CR-253.

No right-of-way is required.
