



Access Management on AL-6 (US-82)

from Echola Road to Buhl Cutoff Road

Get Involved!

The Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT) is developing an access management plan along AL-6 (US-82) corridor from MP 31.25 to MP 36.5 in Tuscaloosa County. Information about the project is available to the public for review and comment. Your comments may be provided by US mail, email, voicemail, or online as described below. Comments for the study must be submitted by **July 10, 2024**.



Project Description

The proposed access management plan along the AL-6 (US-82) corridor will preserve the functional integrity and capacity of the roadway, while reducing conflict points that degrade the roadway’s safety performance. Access management along the corridor will include the closure of median openings, restriction of turning movements, and modifying existing turn lanes.

Where a median opening remains along the study corridor, left turn lanes are proposed to be modified to meet current standards.

Another proposed improvement is the restriction of turning movements. This helps to reduce the number of conflict points, which reduces the likelihood of a crash.

In summary, of the existing 18 median openings:

- a. Seven (7) are proposed to be closed/removed.
- b. Three (3) are proposed to be modified with restricted turning movements.
- c. Eight (8) are proposed to have their lengths and widths adjusted to meet current standards.

ALDOT is interested in obtaining input from the people who use this route.
