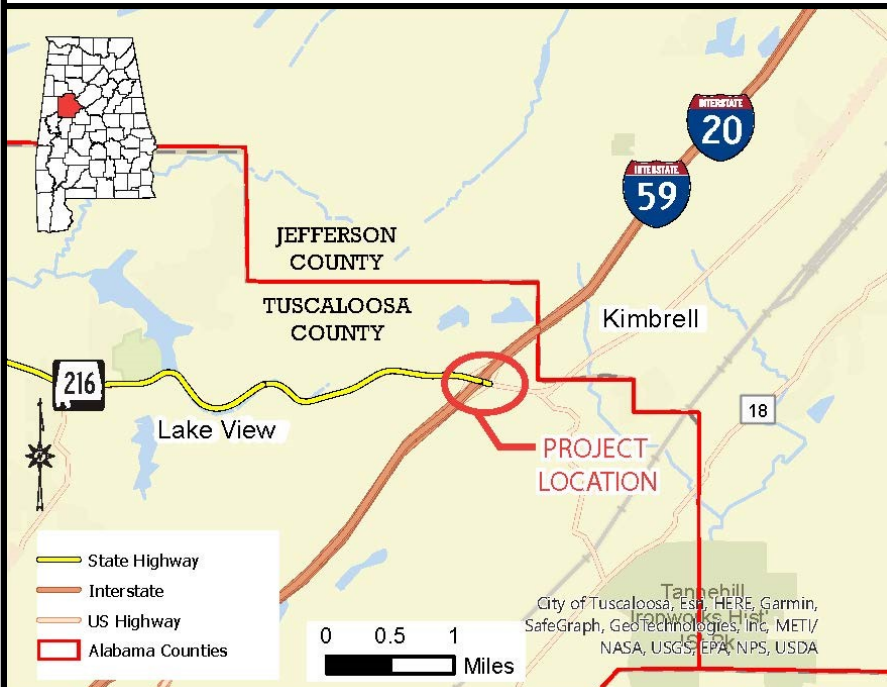

Additional Lanes and Bridge Replacement on AL-216 from Youngblood Parkway to the I-59 East Ramp of Exit 100

The Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT) proposes to add lanes from Youngblood Parkway to the I-59 East Ramp of Exit 100 and replace a bridge on AL-216 over I-59-20 in McCalla, Alabama. Information about the project is available to the public for review and comment. Comments may be provided by US mail, email, voicemail, or online as described below. Comments for the proposed project must be submitted by **February 19, 2024**.



Project Description

The purpose of this project is to address present and future traffic flow, traffic congestion, and access management on AL-216 at Exit 100. During the morning and afternoon rush hours, traffic backs up onto AL-216 and on the exit ramps. The proposed improvement is to construct a Diverging Diamond Interchange (DDI) to allow for the heavy left turning traffic to flow more freely, add additional lanes from Youngblood Parkway to the I-59 East Ramp of Exit 100, and provide access management through the project.

The project would require replacing the existing bridge over I-59 and adding lanes on AL-216 from Youngblood Parkway to the end of AL-216.

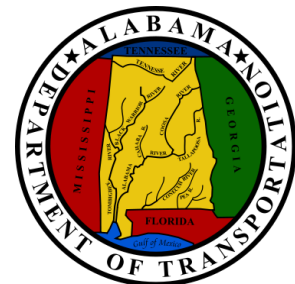
