



Bridge Replacements on AL-15 (US-29) Over Big Creek, Sina Creek, and Hornet Creek

The Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT) is proposing to replace three bridges on AL-15 (US-29) in Covington and Crenshaw County. Information about the project is available to the public for review and comment. Your comments may be provided by US mail, email, or online as described below. Comments for the proposed project must be submitted by **May 30, 2025**.



Project Description

The purpose of the proposed project is to replace the existing bridges with modern structures that meet current standards and are capable of handling existing and future traffic demands. The proposed work includes:

- Replacing bridge over Big Creek.
- Replacing bridge over Sina Creek.
- Replacing bridge over Hornet Creek
