

### Intersection Improvements on US-72

The Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT) is proposing to improve the intersection of US-72 and Cambridge Lane just east of Athens, Limestone County, Alabama. Information about the project is available to the public for review and comment. Your comments may be provided by US mail, email, voicemail or online as described below. Comments for the proposed project must be submitted by **January 10, 2025**.



### Project Description

*Limited sight distance while maneuvering in and out of the median crossover at the US-72 and Cambridge Lane intersection presents a safety concern for the traveling public.*

*Initially, ALDOT proposed to close the crossover and install a reduced-conflict intersection (RCI). Due to input provided at the initial public involvement meeting held on September 26, 2023 and additional traffic studies, changes were made to the project design.*

*ALDOT now proposes to install a traffic signal at the intersection to address safety concerns.*
