



Access Management Along AL-210 (Ross Clark Circle) From Kelley Drive to Medical Park Boulevard

The Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT) is proposing to improve traffic flow and address safety concerns by modifying access and reducing conflict points along AL-210 (Ross Clark Circle) in Dothan and Houston County. Information about the project is available to the public for review and comment. Your comments may be provided by US mail, email, or online as described below and must be submitted by **March 28, 2025**.



Project Description

The purpose of the proposed project is to improve traffic flow and address safety concerns on this section of roadway in Dothan. The proposed work includes:

- Adding concrete islands in the median to restrict unsafe turning movements.
- Addition of U-turns lanes to provide access to the opposite of the roadway.
