



## AL-215 Improvements

The Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT) is proposing improvements along AL-215 (University Blvd) from the intersection of AL-216/15th Street/University Boulevard to Church Street including intersection modification at the intersection of AL-7/US-11/Skyland Blvd in Cottondale, Tuscaloosa County, Alabama. Information about the project is available to the public for review and comment. Your comments may be provided by US mail, email, voicemail, or online as described below. Comments for the proposed project must be submitted by **October 3, 2025**.



### Project Description

*ALDOT proposes replacing the existing intersections of AL-215 with US-11 and Buttermilk Road with a standard T-intersection. The project also includes widening AL-215 to two lanes in both directions from west of AL-216 to Prude Mill Road. This project is expected to improve traffic congestion along the corridor, effectively handle detour traffic from the interstate, increase safety and maintain access to local businesses.*

*Based on input provided at the initial public involvement meeting on March 18, 2025, as well as field conditions discovered during the design process, changes were made to the project.*

*Additional right-of-way and temporary construction easements are needed to improve drainage and provide better roadway geometry. To improve intersection safety, the right-out access from the Exxon onto AL-215 at US-11 was removed, and the access road was redesigned from a two-lane layout to a one-way configuration to improve mobility and safety.*

*The proposed bulb-out was relocated to improve traffic operations, and additional right-of-way is needed to accommodate the increased turning radius at the intersection.*

*A temporary construction easement is also required to build a new driveway into South's Finest Meats from Prude Mill Road, and a right-in access from US-11 was added.*
