**PURPOSE AND SCOPE: PURPOSE AND SCOPE:** To provide funding for the MPOs within Alabama so that each one can perform the tasks laid out in each organization's Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP). Funding is determined by the urbanized area population based on the decennial census. Alabama has a consolidated planning agreement that includes Planning Funds (PL) and 5303 Transit Funds.

**PROPOSED ACTIVITIES FOR FY 2026**: Allocated funding will be provided to each MPO for duties described in each organization's UPWP. MPOs will use these funds to create their FY 2027 UPWPs; to update their TIPs, LRTPs, PPPs, Bicycle and Pedestrian Plans, and bylaws; to make purchases; to travel and attend ALDOT approved training sessions; and to perform other duties as described in their UPWP.
