



Resurfacing on AL-14 from West of Holbrook Place to AL-61

The Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT) proposes to resurface AL-14 from West of Holbrook Place to AL-61 through Greensboro in Hale County, Alabama. Information about the project is available to the public for review and comment. Your comments may be provided by US mail, email, voicemail, or online as described below. Comments for the proposed project must be submitted by **September 27, 2025**.



Project Description

The intent of the project is to resurface from west of Holbrook Place to AL-61. The project will include a road diet from four (4) travel lanes to two (2) travel lanes and a two-way center turn lane from Main Street to Tuscaloosa Street. This will allow for the separation of thru traffic and designated space for left-turn movements. It will also provide for improved sight lines for the left turn movements at the intersection of AL-14 and Demopolis Street. In addition, striping changes are proposed at the intersection of AL-14 and Hobson Street to more clearly delineate right-of-way at the intersection.
