

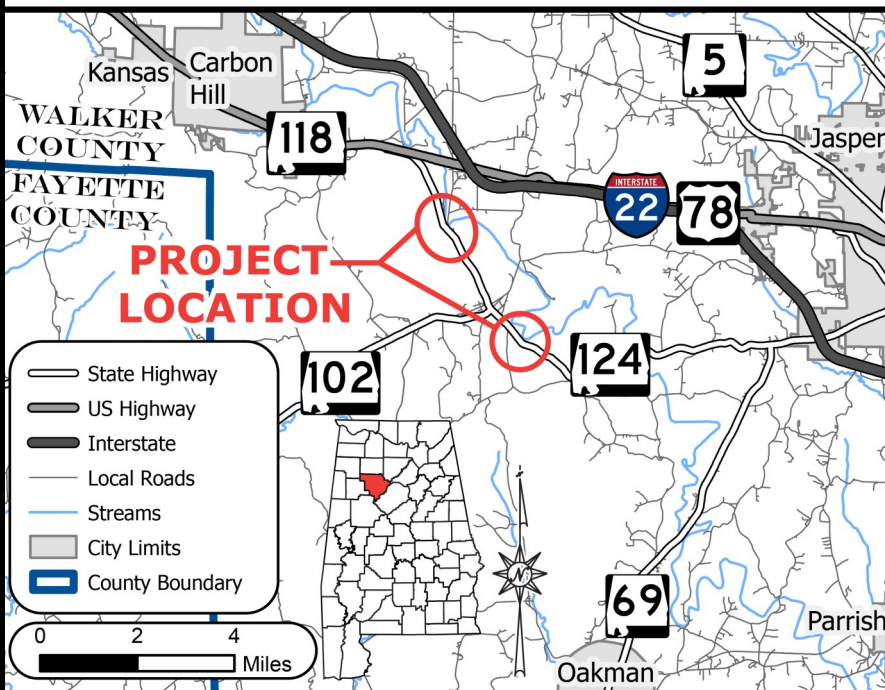

Bridge Replacements on AL-124

The Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT) is proposing replacement of the existing bridges on AL-124 over Downey Branch, the West Fork of Lost Creek, and Hurricane Creek near Townley in Walker County, Alabama. Information about the project is available to the public for review and comment. Your comments may be provided by US mail, email, voicemail, or online as described below. Comments for the proposed project must be submitted by **August 25, 2026**.



Project Description

The purpose of this project is to address aging infrastructure and functional deficiencies of the existing bridges. The bridges were constructed in 1924 and do not meet modern design standards due to the narrow width of the existing bridges.

The new bridges will provide for 12-ft travel lanes and 6-ft shoulders.

The construction of these bridges will require an off-site detour around the project sites utilizing AL-118 and I-22.
