

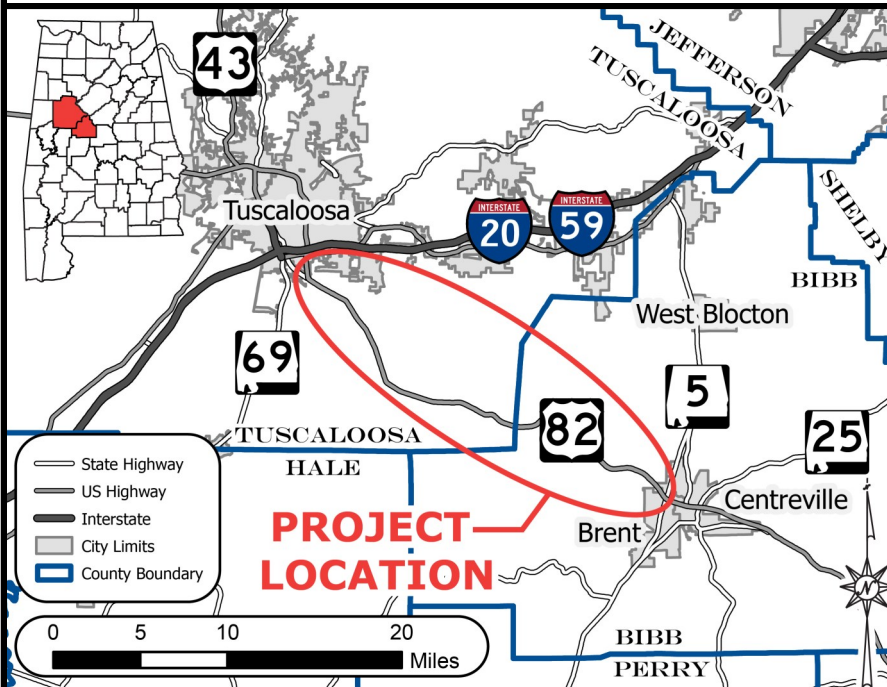

US-82 Access Management

The Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT) is proposing access management improvements for approximately 26 miles of AL-6/US-82 in Tuscaloosa and Bibb Counties. Information about the project is available to the public for review and comment. Your comments may be provided by US mail, email, voicemail, or online as described below. Comments for the proposed project must be submitted by **October 30, 2026**.



Project Description

The purpose of the project is to implement access management along AL-6/US-82 to enhance the roadway's safety performance while preserving the functional integrity and capacity of the roadway. The proposed project focuses heavily on controlling the location and design of existing and future access points along the corridor. It is the goal of the project to preserve the integrity of the existing and future access points, while providing recommended improvements to ensure they are being utilized in the most efficient manner. The result will be a safer, more continuous flow of traffic throughout the project area corridor.
