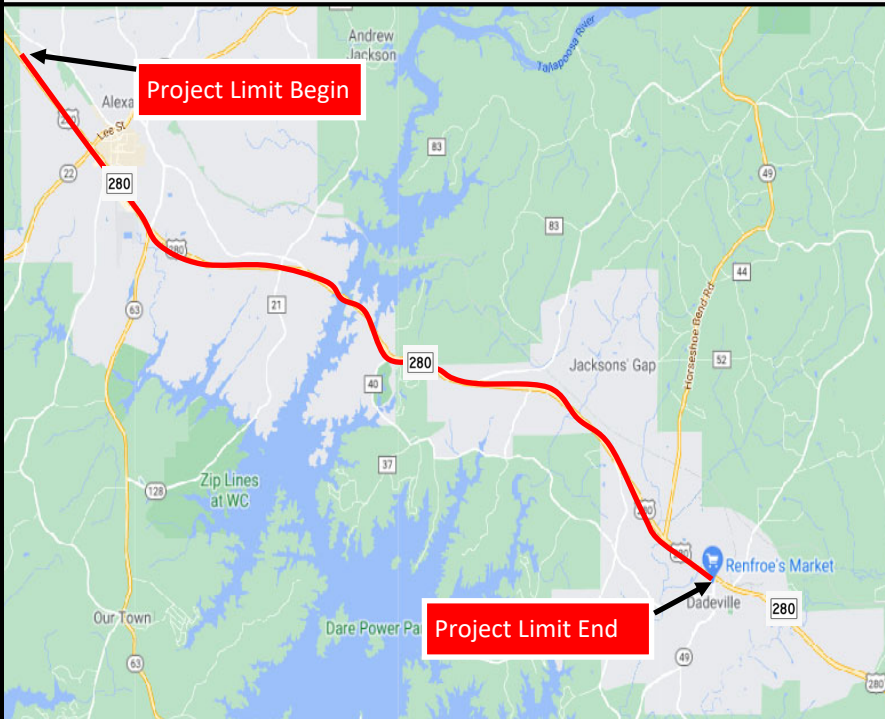




# Public Involvement

## Access and Safety Improvements on US-280

The Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT), in cooperation with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), are proposing a project along AL-38 (US-280) from the Coosa County Line northwest of Alexander City to AL-49 in Dadeville. The proposed project is approximately 17 miles long and will provide access improvements along the length of the project. Your comments may be provided by mail, email, or voicemail as described below. The deadline to provide comments on the proposed project is **September 24, 2021**.
