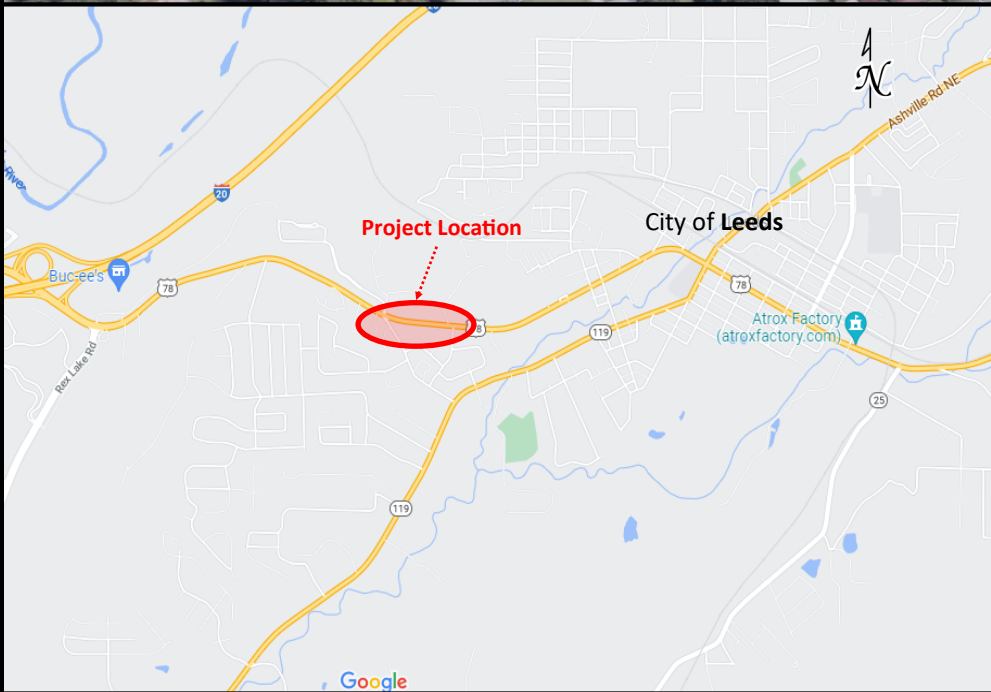

STPAA-0004543) INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS AT PARKWAY DRIVE AL-4 (US-78) AND PRESIDENT STREET IN THE CITY OF LEEDS JEFFERSON COUNTY



The City of Leeds in cooperation with the Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT), is proposing to improve traffic operations of Parkway Drive, AL-4 (US-78), by providing safe turning movements for access to several facilities. These facilities include Leeds High School, Leeds Primary School, the City of Leeds City Hall, Civic Center, Police Station and Fire Station.

Project Description The project is approximately 0.5 mile in length. Improvements to Parkway Drive will begin west of President Street and end east of Roosevelt Drive. The work to be done includes widening Parkway Drive from 2 lanes to 3 lanes to accommodate a center left- turn lane and the addition of curb and gutter. Sidewalks will be added along the north side of Parkway Drive. Right of way will be required for project construction.
