ALDOT project adding lanes on Alabama Highway 167 begins Monday

MONTGOMERY, Ala.— A project aimed to move traffic more efficiently on Alabama Highway 167 from the Boll Weevil Circle to Salem Road will see work begin soon.

The project will add an additional lane in each direction and a center turn lane on Alabama Highway 167. Motorists should see signs being installed along the project limits on Monday, October 3, weather permitting, with work beginning soon after.

There may be moments throughout the project when a lane closure will be necessary for the safety of the workers, but one lane in each direction should remain open through majority of the project.

Motorists are advised to plan accordingly for delays and to be mindful of people and equipment in the work zone.

The approximately \$13 million contract was awarded to S.A. Graham Company, Inc., out of Brundidge, Ala. who had the lowest bid that met project requirements. The project is expected to be complete by Fall 2024.
