RE: Contractor Detour Roads
Around Posted Bridges

Due to our posted bridge situation, some contractors are seeking permission to construct detours (haul roads) around posted bridges to accommodate their vehicles. Such requests should be handled as follows:

- (1) A permit must be obtained from the Department (Maintenance Bureau).
- (2) Minimum signing should be as per the attached sketch which was prepared by the Traffic Section of the Design Bureau.
- (3) A Corps of Engineers permit must be obtained by the contractor if more than 200 cubic yards of fill material is placed below ordinary high water or if the detour falls within a wetland area. If there are any questions about the environmental aspects, you should contact Mr. Bill Carwile, Environmental Coordinator, Design Bureau.

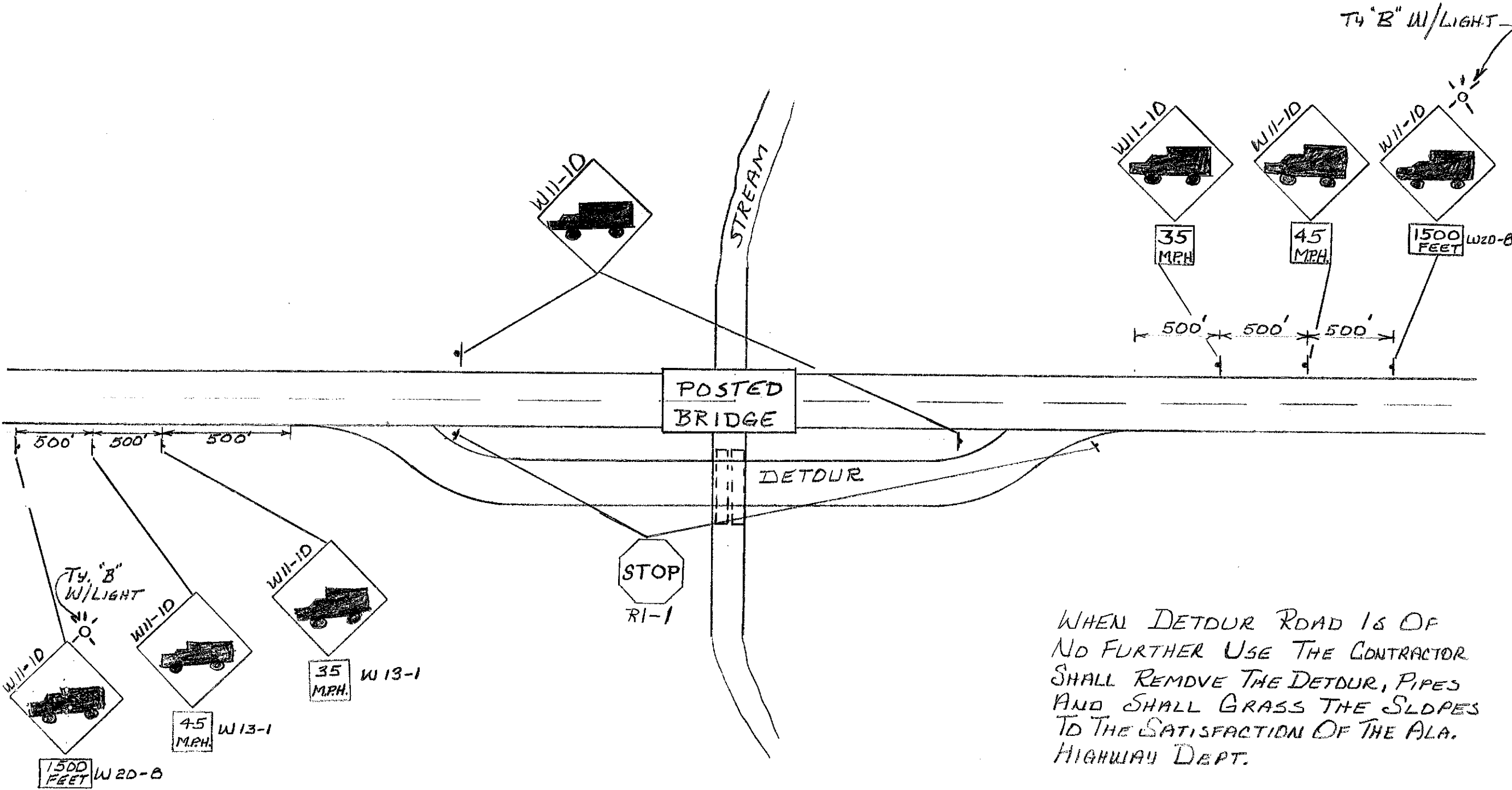
