

102 PROPOSAL REQUIREMENTS AND CONDITIONS

Bidding requirements and conditions for contractors are addressed in ALDOT Standard Specifications for Highway Construction (SSHC) Section 102.

102-1 NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS (ADVERTISEMENT).

102-2 QUALIFICATION OF BIDDERS.

Pre-qualification. Each prime contractor that performs work for ALDOT must pre-qualify with the State of Alabama.

Disqualification. In the case of possible disqualification for unsatisfactory progress in accordance with SSHC 108.04(e), the project manager should forward a letter with relevant information to the Area Construction Engineer for review. The Area Construction Engineer will review the records and forward a recommendation to the Construction Bureau. Following review, the Construction Bureau will proceed with further action as necessary. When a contractor is disqualified, close communication is needed between the Construction Bureau and Office Engineer since disqualification affects the contractor's ability to bid.
