The contractor is required to follow federal immigration law and not employ undocumented immigrants.

A contract bond is a financial guarantee to ALDOT against the failure of a contractor to meet the obligations of its contract. Contractors awarded contracts must provide various bonds to ALDOT. These include performance, labor, materials, feed stuffs, services, insurance, bond, or supplies bonds. A bond is furnished by an insurance company, or surety. These bonds are provided to Office Engineer as part of the contract award process.
