Edward N. Austin was appointed Chief Engineer for ALDOT on October 1, 2020 by the Transportation Director and Governor.

In accordance with the Code of Alabama, the Chief Engineer coordinates the general mathematical, physical, and engineering sciences as applied to the planning and design of highways and bridges in Alabama. The duties of the Chief Engineer

are subject to and under the direction, control, and supervision of the Transportation Director.

Edward began working with ALDOT in 1991 after graduating from Auburn University with a Bachelor of Civil Engineering degree. Edward is a Registered Professional Engineer in the State of Alabama.

He has held engineering positions in several bureaus during his ALDOT career, including Design Bureau, Bridge Bureau, Local Transportation Bureau and Innovative Programs Bureau. Prior to his appointment as Chief Engineer, Edward served as Assistant Chief Engineer for Policy and Planning since 2016.
