

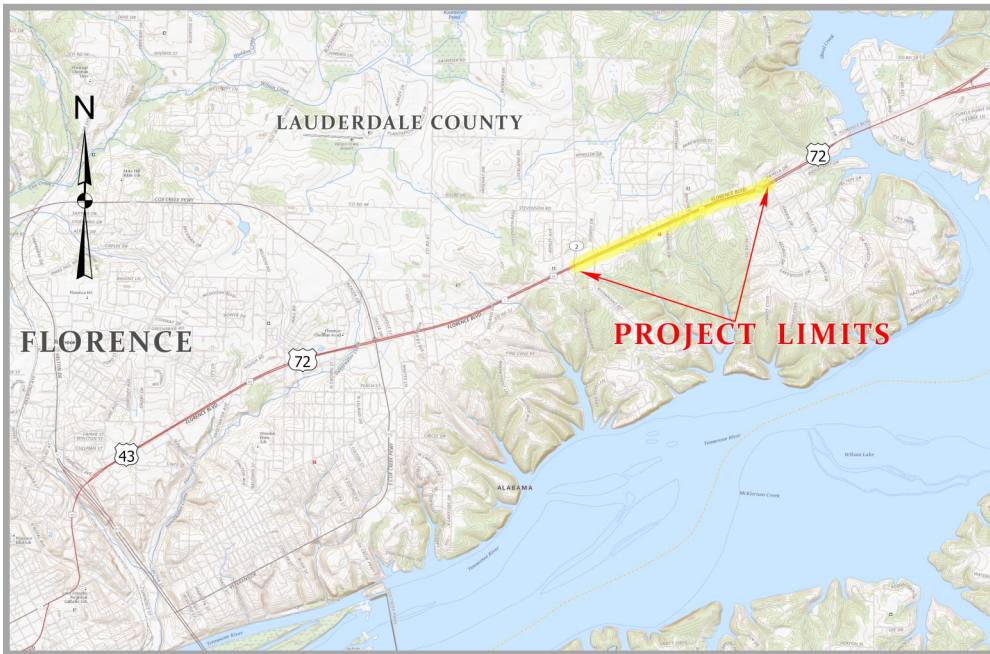


Online Public Involvement

Add Lanes on Florence Blvd (US-72) from Indian Springs Drive to Harris Drive



The Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT) is proposing to add lanes on Florence Blvd (US-72) from Indian Springs Drive to east of Harris Drive. Information about the project is available to the public for review and comment. Your comments may be provided by mail, email, or voicemail as described below. Your comments on the proposed project must be submitted by Monday, **September 21, 2020**.



Project Description

Florence Boulevard (US 72) is a major east-west highway located in the urbanized eastern outskirts of Florence. This project proposal includes the addition of two (2) lanes (one eastbound and one westbound), to the existing 4-lane roadway. The lanes will be added to the outside of the existing lanes. Right and left turning lanes will be added at various intersections to accommodate better traffic flow. The completed project will provide 6 lanes and will also include a 10-ft shared use path. Right of way is required for this project.

The purpose of the project is to increase the capacity of a heavily traveled roadway in order to satisfy demands of the traveling public for more efficient and effective traffic flow.
