

Public and Stakeholder Meeting Comments Alabama 2040 Statewide Transportation Plan (SWTP) September 2016

Statewide transportation goals guide ALDOT in evaluating and prioritizing program and policy recommendations. The draft SWTP goals are aligned with national transportation goals and include:

- Improve reliability and reduce congestion on the statewide roadway network
- Ensure a state of good repair along roadways and bridges throughout the state
- Improve economic benefits by supporting public and private sector investment in the statewide network
- Prioritize improvements that preserve mobility on the statewide network
- Promote the safety and security of the transportation network by reducing traffic-related deaths and serious injuries
- Make more effective and efficient use of limited funding through the enhanced application of data-driven decision making processes, particularly for project selection
- Promote the use of technologies to monitor and enhance system performance
- Promote and enhance the human and natural environment
