Long-Range Transportation Plans

In order to meet the requirements of 23 U.S.C. 134 and 23 C.F.R 450, Alabama Metropolitan Planning Organizations will soon be required to begin coordinating efforts for their 2045 long-range transportation plan. This notification serves as the first request-for-information in this regard. The purpose of this memorandum is to request each MPO to verify their study area boundary for the purpose of collecting external counts from ALDOT. The current study area boundary map is attached to this letter. An ArcGIS file can be accessed via the ALDOT sftp site.

During the development of long-range transportation plans, it will be necessary to transfer several files back and forth between ALDOT and the MPO. ALDOT has obtained approval to migrate to a new server for large file transfers. The site, **sftp.dot.state.al.us**, has been tested and is ready to use. A client software in conjunction with valid username and password are essential for accessing the SFTP site. Instructions for accessing this site are also attached.



MPO Study Areas




