DEFORMED AND PLAIN STEEL BAR PRODUCING MILLS

1. **Material:** Deformed and Plain Steel Reinforcement Bars
2. **Specification:** Section 502 and 835
3. **Jurisdiction:** Product Evaluation Board, Physical Testing Section
4. **Job Acceptance Requirements:** A certified test report showing actual test results of the heat of steel used on the project.
5. **Project Engineer's Responsibility:** Check and assure that the materials are from a manufacturing facility on the approved list. Products not from an approved facility on the list are unacceptable.
6. **Producer's Initial Requirements:** Companies wishing to have products evaluated for placement on this list must contact the:

- 6.1 All steel produced must meet the requirements of AASHTO M 31 for the intended application to be placed on the approved list.
- 6.2 Submittal fee and Product Evaluation Form to the Product Evaluation Board according to Department Procedure ALDOT - 355.
7. **Producer's Maintenance Requirements:** Companies with manufacturing facilities on this list will be expected to comply with the following to remain on the list:
 - 7.1 Produce the same quality of material as the material supplied for the original evaluation.
 - 7.2 Provide only approved products to Department projects.
 - 7.3 Promptly report to the Department any changes in company name, product name, company address or company ownership.
 - 7.4 Participate and successfully complete an annual AASHTO Product Evaluation and Audit Solutions audit and furnish the Department with a copy of the final report.
 - 7.5 Notify the Department of any changes in production of the product. Any alteration that will change the product physically will require a reevaluation.
8. **Laboratory Testing:** Department will conduct selected verification testing of the product to ensure compliance with the Department's Specifications. See the Testing Manual for verification sampling and testing requirements.
9. **Contractors' Requirements:** The prime contractor will be responsible for purchasing and using only approved products.
10. **Removal of Products:** Products may be removed from this list for any of the following:
 - 10.1 Mislabeling products or substitution of products other than those originally submitted.
 - 10.2 Failure to comply with any of the Department's requirements for this type of material.
 - 10.3 Failure to work satisfactorily on the job.
