- 2. <u>Specification:</u> Sections 533, 535, 605, 606, 851, 852, & 854
- 3. <u>Jurisdiction:</u> Product Evaluation Board, Chemical Laboratory
- 4. <u>Job Acceptance Requirements:</u> A certified test report showing actual test results of the lot of pipe used on the project. For diameter of 10 inches or less, sample (3) pieces three foot long from any lot number, any size at the jobsite and submit to the Central Lab for testing.
- 5. **Project Engineer's Responsibility:** Check and assure that the materials are from a manufacturing facility on the approved list. Products not from an approved facility on the list are unacceptable.

- 7. **Producer's Maintenance Requirements:** Companies with manufacturing facilities on this list will be expected to comply with the following to remain on the list:
- 7.1 Produce the same quality of material as the material supplied for the original evaluation.
- 7.2 Provide only approved products to Department projects.
- 7.3 Promptly report to the Department any changes in company name, product name, company address or company ownership.
- 7.4 Participate and successfully complete an annual AASHTO audit and furnish the Department with a copy of the final report.
- 7.5 Notify the Department of any changes in production of the product. Any alteration that will change the product physically will require a reevaluation of the product.
- Laboratory Testing: Department will conduct selected verification testing of the product to insure compliance with the Department's Specifications. See the Testing Manual for verification sampling and testing requirements.
- 9. <u>Contractors' Requirements:</u> The prime contractor will be responsible for purchasing and using only approved products.
- 10. <u>**Removal of Products:**</u> Products may be removed from this list for any of the following:
- 10.1 Mislabeling products or substitution of products other than those originally submitted.
- 10.2 Failure to comply with any of the Department's requirements for this type of material.
- 10.3 Failure to work satisfactorily on the job.
