ASPHALT RELEASE COATING FOR TRUCK BEDS

1. **Material:** Truck bed coating for release of hot mix asphalt. Audit Programs test results will be evaluated per ALDOT-429.
2. **Specification:** Item 410.03(a) 3
3. **Jurisdiction:** Product Evaluation Board, HMA Laboratory
4. **Job Acceptance Requirements:** No Job Control samples required if material comes from a listed source and performs satisfactorily. Submit samples to the Central Laboratory if the material is suspected of being inferior.
5. **Project Engineer's Responsibility:** Check and ensure that the materials are on the approved list.
6. **Producer's Initial Requirements:** Companies wishing to have products evaluated for placement on this list should submit the product to AASHTO Product Evaluation and Audit Solutions (formerly National Product Evaluation Program (NTPEP)) – Asphalt Release Agents:

After the product is evaluated by AASHTO Product Evaluation and Audit Programs, and results have been uploaded to DataMine, provide the Department's Product Evaluation Engineer with the following:
 - 6.1.1 Written request to place the product on this list.
 - 6.1.2 Copy of the final AASHTO Product Evaluation and Audit Programs report.
 - 6.1.3 Product data sheets to provide all pertinent information relative to the product to be evaluated, including, but not limited to: manufacturer's specifications, mixing instructions, recommended application procedure and rate, typical analysis and Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS).
 - 6.1.4 Submittal and certification review fees according to Department procedure ALDOT-355.
- 6.2 The product and AASHTO Product Evaluation and
7. **Producer's Maintenance Requirements:**
 - 7.1 Produce the same quality of material as the material supplied for the original evaluation.
 - 7.2 Provide only approved products to Department projects.
 - 7.3 Notify the Department within thirty (30) days of any changes in company name, product name, company address or company ownership.
 - 7.4 Notify the Department of any changes in production of the product. Any alteration that will change the product chemically or physically will require a re-evaluation of the product.
 - 7.5 Products must maintain current status with AASHTO Product Evaluation and Audit Programs. This requires re-evaluation every 3 years.
8. **Contractors' Requirements:** The prime contractor will be responsible for purchasing and using only approved products.
9. **Removal of Products:** Products may be removed from this list for any of the following:
 - 9.1 Mislabeling products or substitution of products other than those originally submitted.
 - 9.2 Failure to comply with any of the Department's requirements of this procedure or Department Specifications.
 - 9.3 Failure to work satisfactorily in the field.
 - 9.4 Poor evaluation results from AASHTO Product Evaluation and Audit Programs.
 - 9.5 Failure to maintain current status with AASHTO Product Evaluation and Audit Programs.
 - 9.6 A continued pattern of failure of products to be within the quality control limits set in the specifications.
